

Clean Your Hands

Hand Washing		Hand Sanitizing
	Wet hands with warm running water.	If your hands look dirty: STOP Wash them with soap and water first. If your hands look clean: GO Hand sanitize.
	Apply liquid soap.	Apply the alcohol-based hand rub to your hands (minimum 60% alcohol). A thumbnail-sized amount is sufficient. If you just washed your hands, be sure they are completely dry or the moisture left could dilute the alcohol and reduce its effectiveness.

Be sure to scrub: > between your fingers > your fingertips and fingernails, > the back of your hands and wrists. your hands for ime it takes to sing "Happy	Rub your hands together. Don't forget: between your fingers your fingertips and fingernails, the back of your hands and wrists. Rub your hands until the alcohol evaporates. Hands will feel dry in about 15 seconds.
	Rinse well under running water.	protect others! Protect yourself!
	Dry your hands with paper towels.	
	Use the paper towel to turn off the taps.
