This letter is to confirm that the South West Region Infant Hearing Program (IHP) will receive one-time funding in the amount of \$141,000 for 2011-2012. These funds will support the purchase of new infant hearing screening equipment in your region. Please note the purchase of this new equipment cannot proceed until the Ministry announces the new Supplier later this month. Your staff will be notified as soon as this takes place so they can proceed with the purchase of equipment.

These funds are one-time only and will not be added to your agency's IHP base budget. Funds must be spent by March 31, 2012 and reflected in your agency's quarterly financial reports and year-end settlement.

THIS AMENDING AGREEMENT is effective as of the 29th day of February, 2012.

BETWEEN:

**HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF ONTARIO
as represented by the Minister of Children and Youth Services
(the "Ministry")**

- and -

**Middlesex-London District Health Unit
(the "Recipient")**

WHEREAS the Ministry and the Recipient entered into an agreement (the "Agreement") dated April 1, 2011;

AND WHEREAS the Ministry and the Recipient have agreed to amend the Agreement in the manner set forth in this Amending Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained and other good and valuable consideration (the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged), the parties covenant and agree as follows:

1. Unless otherwise specified, capitalized words and phrases in this Amending Agreement have the meaning set out in the Agreement.
2. Other than as set out above, the Agreement remains unaltered and in full force and effect.
3. This Amending Agreement and the Agreement constitute the entire agreement between the parties.
4. The Recipient shall purchase all IHP hearing screening equipment from the Supplier, as indicated by the Ministry. Only the hearing screening equipment specifically selected by the Ministry can be purchased for use within IHP.
5. Notwithstanding section 11.1 of the Agreement, the Recipient shall not proceed with any purchase of automated distortion product otoacoustic emissions (ADPOAE) screening equipment, automated auditory brainstem response (AABR) screening equipment or combined ADPOAE/AABR screening equipment that supports the IHP Project without the prior written consent of the Ministry.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Ministry and the Recipient have respectively executed and delivered this Amending Agreement effective as of the date set out above.
