# The Baby-Friendly Initiative

- A global evidence-based strategy
- Ensures informed infant feeding decisions
- Improves the health and development of all infants and children
- Consists of 10 Steps & the WHO Code







# Ministry of Health and Long Term Care

- Baby-Friendly Initiative designation is an Accountability Health Promotion Indicator for Family Health
- Requirements have been set out by the Ministry (preliminary, intermediate, advanced, designation)





#### Implementation Update

- Began formal designation process (Nov 2013)
- Pre-Assessment Documentation Review (Dec - Jan 2014)
- Pre-Assessment Site Visit (Sept 2014)
- External Assessment (Fall 2015)





## **BOH Requirements**

- Review and endorse policy revisions
- Complete annual orientation to MLHU BFI policy
- Prepare for final assessment visit prior to designation
