

ACCEPTABLE I.D.


Skin Cancer Prevention Act (Tanning Beds), 2013, Section 2(2)

It is against the law to sell, offer for sale or provide tanning services or ultraviolet light treatments for tanning to an individual who appears to be less than 25 years old unless you have required the individual to produce identification and you are satisfied that the individual is at least 18 years old.

Acceptable I.D. must include a photograph of the individual, must state their date of birth and must reasonably appear to have been issued by a government.


Ontario Driver's Licence (newer version)



Ontario Photo Card




Ontario Driver's Licence (Older Version)
