Children In Need Of Treatment

**The Middlesex-London Health Unit
has a program that may help you.**

The Middlesex-London Health Unit operates a program called **CINOT** which may pay for dental care for persons age 17 years and under who qualify. If approved under **CINOT**, the person may attend the dentist he or she chooses for care. Cleanings, fillings, extractions and some root canals are covered.

To Qualify:

- The person must be age 17 years and younger.
- The person must require immediate/urgent dental care as determined by the Middlesex-London Health Unit oral health staff. (For example, toothache, pain, swelling, or visible cavities.) Routine, regular dental checkups are not covered. The CINOT program is NOT intended for repeated use for dental care.
- The person must **not** have any dental plan coverage (Dental Insurance or Ontario Works).
- The person's parents must sign a form indicating it would be a financial hardship to pay for the necessary care.
