

Butterfly Life Cycle

ACTIVITY GOAL: To observe the life cycle of a butterfly to spark students' interest in nature and exploring the outdoors.

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Purchase a Butterfly Grow Kit. Kits can be purchased from board approved stores or online.
- 2. Visit the <u>Middlesex-London Health Unit website</u> to download a copy of Murray & Bird: Murray's Outdoor Adventure storybook.
- 3. Read the book for the class.
- 4. As a class, set up the Butterfly Grow Kit.
 - a. Have students complete the **Butterfly Life Cycle activity sheet**.
 - b. As a class, make and track observations as the butterfly develops through the different stages of its life cycle (e.g., colour, shape, activity, diet).
- 5. Release your adult butterfly outside according to the instructions from your Butterfly Grow Kit.
