

Fun Movement Activities for Students

ACTIVITY GOAL: To reduce sedentary behaviour by incorporating movement into learning and storytime.

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Visit the <u>Middlesex-London Health Unit website</u> to download a copy of Murray & Bird: Murray's Outdoor Adventure storybook.
- 2. Read the book for the class.
- Incorporate movement into your storytime with some of the examples below:
 - a. Fuzzy Little Caterpillar Movement Activity
 - b. Outdoor Obstacle Course





Fuzzy Little Caterpillar

A fun movement activity for students



Activity Instructions:

- 1. Explain to students that they will be acting out the stages of the butterfly life cycle illustrated in the Murray & Bird: Murray's Outdoor Adventure storybook using movement.
- 2. Have students spread out in the classroom or outside. Begin by sitting on the ground, curling legs up close to the body to look like a caterpillar egg.
- 3. Have students move along to the educator prompts below (song can be sung to the tune of *I'm a Little Teapot*):

Stage 1: Egg



Educator says: "The caterpillar egg sits completely still on a leaf. Then, the egg begins to shake. The caterpillar is about to hatch!"

While curled up like an egg, start rocking side-to-side

Educator sings: "Little fuzzy caterpillar, your time has finally come. Hatch from your egg, let's see what you become!

Stage 2: Caterpillar



Educator says: "The caterpillar hatches and comes out of it's egg!"

Untuck your legs and arms and start crawling like a caterpillar

Educator sings: "Little fuzzy caterpillar crawling all around. Look at you go as you move around"

Stage 3: Chrysalis or pupa (cocoon)



Educator says: "It's time for the caterpillar to start making their cocoon"

Stand up and spin in circles and then stand still

Educator sings: "Little fuzzy caterpillar in your warm cocoon. Spin yourself a blanket, you will wake up soon"

Stage 4: Butterfly



Educator says: "The caterpillar comes out of its cocoon"

Spread your arms and pretend to fly like a butterfly

Educator sings: "Little fuzzy caterpillar it's time for you to fly. Look, you have two wings. You're a butterfly!"



Outdoor Obstacle Course

A fun movement activity for students



Activity Instructions:

- 1. Have students collect items around the school and schoolyard to recreate the different scenes from Murray's Outdoor Adventure storybook.
- 2. Set up the different scenes around the schoolyard in the form of an obstacle course.
- 3. Students can take turns going through the obstacles.
