



<u>Infection Control Presentation Requirements</u>

- 1. The presentation can be done in one morning or afternoon on the same day or be broken down and occur during the same period on two separate weeks. (Approx. time 2.5-3hrs). A good point to split the presentation if you are doing it over two weeks is after the Don't Pass it Along Activity. Start a new day with Breaking the Chain of Infection. The presentation is designed to be delivered to a group of no more than 30 students.
- 2. Print notes packages to give to the students on the day of the presentation. (Select file, then print, then click full page slides and select the 3 slides handout option and print on both sides).
- 3. Print the quiz for the students and answer sheet for yourself if needed. The quiz should take no more than 15-20 minutes to complete. Have the students pass their tests in front or behind them to another student for marking. After marking, return the quizzes to the students. After they have their quiz back, take up the answers.
- 4. Print the Infection Control Don't Pass it Along activity cards and instruction sheet. Ensure that cards are **set to print on both sides** with a picture on one side and possibly a letter on the other (some cards will be blank on one side).
- 5. Print/prep and sign certificates ahead of time.
- 6. Optional: If you decide to do the Glo Germ activity speak to your school Public Health Nurse about the possibility of borrowing these resources.
