Parent/Caregiver Presentation or Event

ACTIVITY GOAL: To increase parent/caregiver awareness around youth substance use and provide strategies for parents/caregivers to use when speaking with their students about substance use.

ACTIVITY IDEAS:

Host a parent information event on substance use.

Potential events could include:

- A keynote speaker
- Panel discussion with community partners
- Display tables with take-away information

Community partners may include: your school Public Health Nurse, School Resource Officer, Canadian Mental Health Association, Addictions Services Thames Valley, School Social Worker(s), Tobacco Enforcement, local police etc.

Topics could include:

- Cannabis
- Electronic Cigarettes/Vaping
- Tobacco
- Alcohol

- Event could be done as a transition to high school event.
