ACTIVITY GOAL: To increase students' knowledge and awareness about current and relevant substance use issues.

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Provide an outline of the project and supporting resources that can guide the students' research on the health topic. See the links in the resources section for examples of sites with credible information.
- Have students research a specific topic relating to substance use (e.g., alcohol, cannabis, opioids, vaping), and create a resource to discuss the associated risks, health effects, and community supports available.
 Possible formats: public service announcements, PowerPoint, Google slides, posters, announcements, pamphlets, videos.
