### ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

Communication of the *Smoke-Free Ontario Act, 2017*

2. Remind parents/caregivers about the *Smoke-Free Ontario Act, 2017* through school-wide communication and events
3. Post smoke-free/vape-free signage at all school entrances, on school grounds, bathroom doors and parking lot areas (contact your school Public Health Nurse to obtain this signage)
