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
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
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


This is Murray the dinosaur
and his best friend Bird.




Murray and Bird are walking down the hall at school and stop to talk to a new student named Sam.

"Maybe you left your hat in the library," chirps Bird. "Let's go ask Mr. Reading."


When they enter the library Mr. Reading is trying to organize his books.

"Oh hi Murray... oh hi Bird... oh hi Sam!" says Ms. Notes.


"Sorry to interrupt your beautiful song, Ms. Notes. Have you seen my hat?" asks Sam.

“I have not seen it, but why don’t we ask Mr. Lesson. He is the wisest and most helpful teacher at school.”






They all walk into Mr. Lesson's classroom.

"I have a special secret pocket in my backpack. Why don't you check if yours does too?"




“It does Mr. Lesson. I found my hat!”
