All vaccines listed below are given at school-based clinics for grade 7 students. Please provide the names of your patients so that MLHU can verify that they have not already received these vaccines at school.

**MENINGOCOCCAL-C-ACYW (Menactra or Nimenrix)**

- Publicly funded beginning in grade 7 through grade 12
- MANDATORY under the Immunization of School Pupils Act
- Different than Men-C-C. If Men-C-C was previously given, must wait at least 28 days before administering Men-C-ACYW
- Administration: One dose

**HUMAN PAPILLOMAVIRUS (Gardasil 9)**

Publicly funded for males & females born in \*2004 or later, beginning when they are in grade 7 until high school graduation. If started series with HPV4, eligible to complete remainder of series with HPV9. If already completed series with HPV4, NOT eligible for HPV9.

\*Males born before 2004 are NOT eligible for publicly funded series through school program

\*Females born before 2004 and still in high school can receive publicly funded HPV9 to finish a series previous started by HPV4 or start the series if they have not yet started (not eligible if a full series of HPV4 has already been administered)

- Exception – Due to pandemic, females born in 2002 and 2003 who have already graduated high school can receive the vaccine publicly funded until August 31, 2022

Administration: If first dose is given between ages 9 and 14 (inclusive): 2 doses (0, 6 months)

- If first dose is given at age or 15 or older, or patient is immunocompromised: 3 doses (0, 2, 6 months)

**HEPATITIS B (Engerix B)**

- Publicly funded through school program only for grade 7 and 8 students
  - Exception – Due to pandemic, grade 9 and 10 students may receive the vaccine publicly funded until August 31, 2022

Administration: For patients 11-15 years old - 2 full ADULT 1mL doses (0, 6 months)

- For patients 16 years and older - a three-dose PEDIATRIC 0.5 ml is recommended (0,1, and 6 month)
