



MAKE MY FIRST TEST AN EYE TEST.

EYE TESTS ARE FREE once a year when you show your child's health card to an optometrist.

Your child needs an eye exam. Even if you think there's nothing wrong with how they can see.

Having your child's vision tested is a key part of getting ready for school.

Having good vision makes it easier for a child to learn.

Children with poor vision often have a hard time doing their school work.

Sometimes they are thought to have a learning or behavioural disability, even when they don't.

Often, there are no signs that a child has a vision problem.

Finding vision problems early is important.

Have your child's eyes tested by an eye doctor before they start school.

Make an eye exam part of your child's back-to-school routine every year.

Your child can have their eyes tested for free.

Children are able to have a free eye exam once a year up to 19 years of age, if they have a health card.
